ELECTION

VOTER REGISTRATION

The Chatham Central School District will hold personal voter registration for qualified voters residing within the District at the times and on the days specified below. Voter registration will take place in the lobby of the Mary E. Dardess Elementary School.

- 4 - 8 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 10, 2009
- 4 - 8 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 5, 2010

You **MUST** register to vote if:

- You are not currently registered to vote with the Columbia County Board of Elections and/or the Chatham Central School District Board of Registration, **OR**
- You have not voted at a Chatham Central School District Special Meeting or Annual Budget Vote during the past four years.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Absentee ballots for the January 12, 2010 Referendum may be applied for at the office of the District Clerk of the Chatham Central School District. Applications for absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk at least seven days prior to the date of the Referendum vote if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. on January 12, 2010.
