Language Arts – In the area of spelling we have been doing some review. The spelling homework each night should be written in their spelling journals. The assignments consist of the following:

Monday – three times each

Tuesday – eight sentences

Wednesday – alphabetical order

Thursday – pretest (must be written in spelling journal for credit).

We are in the middle of our survival/adventure unit. The students are reading Dolphin Treasure by Wayne Grover for our class book. Our read aloud is *Survival* which is the second book in the *Island* series by Gordon Korman. The students wrote adventure stories to go along with the unit. We will be starting biographies soon.

Math – We have covered place value of whole numbers/decimals, comparing whole numbers/decimals, rounding whole numbers and decimals and ordering whole numbers/decimals, graphing, measurement (customary and metric) long multiplication, long division, order of operations, algebra, fractions and geometry. We are currently in our word problem unit.

At this point in time I ask that you check the planners each night for homework assignments and notes from the teachers. After reading them I ask that you initial by each subject that has homework once the assignments are completed and placed in the homework folder.
