Language Arts – In the area of spelling we are working on r controlled vowels. The spelling homework each night should be written in their spelling journals. The assignments consist of the following:

Monday – three times each

Tuesday – eight sentences

Wednesday – alphabetical order

Thursday – pretest (must be written in spelling journal for credit).

We are finishing up our science fiction unit and are busy working on our country projects. In the area of grammar we have been studying different types of verbs. Independent book projects are due on March 26, 2010.

Math – We have covered place value of whole numbers/decimals, comparing whole numbers/decimals, rounding whole numbers and decimals and ordering whole numbers/decimals, graphing, measurement (customary and metric) and long multiplication. Please practice multiplication facts at home, the children are still struggling with them and they really need them for all of the units through the end of the year. We are working on long division and order of operations.

At this point in time I ask that you check the planners each night for homework assignments and notes from the teachers. After reading them I ask that you initial by each subject that has homework once the assignments are completed and placed in the homework folder.
