Consultant Teaching	A model where a special education teacher “pushes” in to a regular classroom to provide services to students.		
AST	Academic Support Teacher—a now discontinued model where 1 special education teacher assigned to a grade level provided all special ed, remediation and enrichment		
RTI	Response to Intervention—a model in which interventions are provided to students who struggle academically, and data is collected on their effectiveness. When an intervention is unsuccessful in improving student achievement, a more intensive intervention is tried. This process is part of the process of identifying students with disabilities.		
Heterogeneous	Class arrangement where students of mixed abilities are grouped together.		
Homogeneous	Class arrangement where students of similar ability are grouped together.
